Task 3. The Math Task: Imagine a family of 6 orders one of everything.

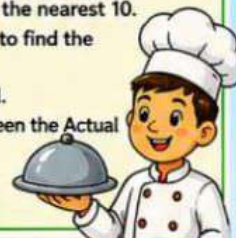
★ Step A: Round off each price to the nearest 10.

Q.2 My 7-Digit Number Tree

Instructions: Choose any 7-digit number (Example: 4,562,193) and use it to complete your drawing of the Number Tree following the steps below.

1. The Main Trunk (The Whole Number)

Write your chosen 7-digit number clearly in the middle of the trunk.

2. The Roots (Face Value)

In the roots of the tree, write each digit of your number separately.

Example: If your number is 4,562,193, the roots will be: 4, 5, 6, 2, 1, 9, 3.

3. The Left Branch (Indian System)

Write your number using the Indian Place Value System.

Comma Placement: Put commas after the hundreds, ten-thousands, and lakhs (e.g., 45,62,193).

Words: Write the name of the number (e.g., Forty-five lakh, sixty-two thousand, one hundred ninety-three).

4. The Right Branch (International System)

Write your number using the International Place Value System.

Comma Placement: Put commas after every three digits from the right (e.g., 4,562,193).

Words: Write the name of the number (e.g., Four million, five hundred sixty-two thousand, one hundred ninety-three).

- Make a model of Solar system with the help of balls of different sizes on a hard cardboard and label all planets. (Roll No. 21 to 45)

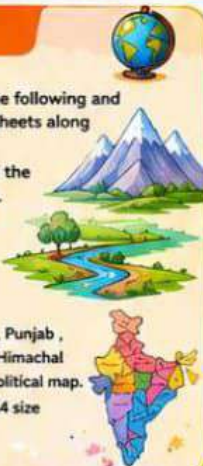
